Groundwater Sustainability Plans (GSPs)

In response to a state law enacted in 2014 - the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) - a roadmap for how groundwater will be managed over the next two decades will be finalized this year. The goal is to balance the amount of groundwater pumped with the amount that is replenished each yea by nature or humans.

The Public Review Draft Groundwater Sustainability Plans for the Bowman, Red Bluff, Antelope, and Los Molinos Subbasins are available for public review and comment through November 19,

Why do we need the plans?

What are in the plans?

Extended drought and historic overpumping threaten the long-term future of groundwater resources necessary to support our needs. including urban, domestic, agricultural, industrial, and environmental. The State requires local agencies to develop and adopt GSPs by January 2022. If the subbasins fail to meet statemandated requirements, the State may intervene at a much higher cost than if we retain local control.




