To properly adopt, implement, and administer the Basin’s Groundwater Sustainability Plans (GSPs), the Tehama County Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) has determined that it needs to obtain the following information from all owners and users of groundwater extraction wells within the GSA Area. As a result, the GSA requires all owners and users of groundwater extraction wells to register with the GSA no later than **March 31, 2023**.

Failure to properly and completely register could adversely affect your property as the information in the form will be used in the implementation of the GSPs and periodic updates. Failure to properly register wells may result in increased well fees.
