FISCAL IMPACT:

BACKGROUND

The City of Red Bluff is applying for a Reclamation Board Permit to replace the existing boat ramp at the City Park with a new ADA compatible ramp. The permit application requires endorsement by the local Flood Control District.

The construction is scheduled to begin in September 2001 after the Diversion Dam gates are raised and as such, no work within the water will be required. Proper storm water runoff prevention measures are planned during construction.

FISCAL IMPACT:

BACKGROUND

The Vina Resource Conservation District (Vina RCD) is applying for a Reclamation Board Permit to conduct streambank stabilization and restoration to reduce erosion of agricultural land on Deer Creek. The proposed project is located approximately 300' downstream from the HWY 99E Bridge on Deer Creek. The permit application requires endorsement by the Local Flood Control District.

The project proposes to install three stream-barbs (bank weirs) to catch sediment which is designed to fill in the eroded area and stabilize the bank. A copy of the Mitigated Negative Declaration is on file at the Board of Supervisors office for review.

Attached is prior correspondence from the Board of Supervisors supporting the Vina Resource Conservation District application for Proposition 204 Funds which have now been secured for this project.

Because the final plans and specifications are not complete at this time, Staff recommends the endorsement include the following conditions:

The Vina RCD provide Tehama County Flood Control and Water Conservation District with a copy of the final plans and specifications.

Calculations be provided that the proposed project will not diminish the Deer Creek Levee project design flow capacity of 21,000cfs with 3' of freeboard.

The Vina RCD will obtain a Floodplain Development Permit from the Tehama County Building Department.

Recommended Action:

1. Endorse the Vina Resource Conservation District Reclamation Permit Application with conditions attached
2. Authorize the Chairperson to sign Application Endorsement.
