MINUTES OF JUNE 15, 2009**

1. **CALL TO ORDER:** Chairman Allan Fulton called the meeting to order at 2:04 p.m.
2. **INTRODUCTIONS:** Kristen McKillop of Butte County Water and Resource Conservation
3. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** Ernie Ohlin presented the committee with a summary of the May Joint Council meeting.

Walt Mansell mentioned developments in State legislature in regards to reformatting conservation districts. Agencies affected include Department of Water Resources, Cal Fire, and Department of Fish and Game.

4. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Motion by Walt Mansell to approve May 11, 2009 minutes, second by Charles Crain and carried 7-0 with 2 absent.
5. **BASIN MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVE INFORMATION CENTER PRESENTATION:** Kristin McKillop gave a presentation on the Butte County Water and Resources website, including trigger levels and awareness actions. Butte County received an AB303 grant to create the website with Tehama and Glenn Counties contributing funds to have data included on the website (www.buttecounty.net/waterandresource)

Allan Fulton commented that Tehama Flood Control and Water Conservation District contributed \$10,000, and questioned if additional funds will be required for maintenance. Kristin commented that at this time Butte County will be covering the maintenance costs.

6. **TAC ANNUAL REPORT:** Allan Fulton presented the draft Annual Report for review. The following changes were suggested:
 - Page 4, Second paragraph: Change the sentence to read “In 2008 an effort was made to add one existing well”.
 - Page 4, Third paragraph: Remove the words “If a grant can be secured.”
 - Ernie Ohlin suggested changing “Future TAC Activities” to include something to the effect of “Conduct a groundwater recharge feasibility study to determine

locations and appropriateness for possible future studies.” In addition, include “Work with Butte, Colusa, Glenn, and Sutter to develop an Integrated Regional Water Management Plan”

7. **DEER CREEK FLOW ENHANCEMENT PROJECT:** Bill Ehorn updated the committee on the Deer Creek Flow Enhancement Project. The permit has been submitted to Tehama County Environmental Health; and is currently in the review phase.

PUBLIC COMMENT (REOPENED AT 3:15 P.M.): The Committee did put out notice and advertise for applicants for the three AB3030 TAC vacancies.

8. **ADJOURN:** With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 3:17 p.m.
