- 1. CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Allan Fulton called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

- 4. AB3030 BY-LAWS UPDATE: Gary Antone announced the AB3030 By-Laws are in the final review stages with County Counsel. It is anticipated the review will be complete the week of August 16, 2010, and will be presented to the Flood Control Board for adoption.
